- **Bidders will be evaluated on the Preference Point System of 80/20 whereby the maximum points are as follows: Price = 80 points and Specific Goals: HDI = 20 points as tabulated above.**
- Service providers claiming specific goals points must provide a valid B-BBEE certificate issued by an accredited body or a sworn affidavit.
- The bidder must provide proof of registration on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which should reflect that the bidder is an active supplier, is tax compliant, not a Government employee and is not a restricted supplier.
